Obtain a GPA of 2.7 or better on UA coursework. Complete technical courses with a grade of "C" or better.

Obtain a passing score on the Math, Reading, and Writing sections of the Praxis Core or ACT as defined by the Arkansas Department of Education. Complete <u>CATE 3103</u> during the fall semester of the sophomore year.

Admission to the Career and Technical Education (CATE) program occurs the semester after the candidate has completed <u>CATE 3103</u> Introduction to Professionalism.

#### The application process includes:

Submission of the application to teacher education through the university-wide Teacher Education Office during spring semester of sophomore year. This includes:

- Completing and passing the criminal background check
- Passing the Praxis I core academic subjects test by meeting or exceeding the Arkansas Department of Education cut-off scores.
- Submission of the CATE application, oral interview with CATE faculty and submission of writing sample.

Another background check will be required prior to graduation in order to be eligible for licensure.
